



**Construction Update: Crews To Install New Permanent Traffic Signal at Elks Drive/Triviz Drive and US 70/North Main Street  
December 22-23, 2024 and January 2-7, 2025  
Update as of Wednesday, December 18, 2024**

Crews will install the new permanent traffic signal at the intersection of Elks Drive/Triviz Drive and US 70/North Main Street the weeks of **December 22-23, 2024** and Jan 2-6, 2025.

Planned activities and traffic impacts include:

**Sunday, Dec. 22, 2024** – Crews will “stand” the new mast arms for the new traffic signal. *Traffic will be held in one direction at a time for 5-10 minutes while this is taking place.*

**Monday, Dec. 23, 2024** – Crews will mount and aim the cameras and equipment on the new traffic signal. *There will be various single lane closures in all four directions while this is taking place.*

**Thursday, January 2-Saturday, January 4, 2025** – Crews will continue to mount and aim the cameras and equipment on the new traffic signal. *There will be various single lane closures in all four directions while this is taking place.*

**Sunday, January 5, 2025** – Crews will start operating the signal and will bag the old, temporary signal. *Traffic may be held briefly and there will be various single lane closures while this is taking place.*

**Monday, January 6 & Tuesday, January 7, 2025** – Crews will remove the old temporary signal. *Traffic may be held briefly and there will be various single lane closures while this is taking place.*

***Motorists traveling in the area on these days should expect delays.***

The project is expected to be completed **late January 2025**.
